CODE of ETHICS

For all Trustees, Officers, Staff, and Volunteers of The Indian Hill Historical Society, the standard of behavior is expected as follows:

- Responsible performance, both professionally and ethically
- Full understanding that they and their activities will reflect on the Society
- Recognition of the importance of maintaining the Society's good reputation
- Avoid the reality and appearance of using their affiliation with the Society for personal advantage
- Maintaining confidential information acquired during performance of duties for the Society.
- The Society's mission, *Keeping Indian Hill's Past and Present Alive for Tomorrow*, should be the foremost goal.
