- 3/13/1990 Investigations made re: possibility of plaques. Committee formed to study possibilities.
- 4/10/1990 Discussion re: eligibility for proposed plaques. Basically, it is to be those structures in <u>From Camargo to Indian Hill</u> and <u>Treasured Landmarks of Indian Hill</u>. Other structures may be nominated by their owners for review.
- 11/1/1991 Historic Landmark Plaque Program established.
- 2/12/1991 Plaque project to be a fund raiser.
- 4/16/1991 Master mold being prepared.
- 1/14/1991 First order for 25 plaques placed with foundry (Matthew International)
- 1992 Village purchased two markers for Blome Road bridge one on each end.
- 5/12/1992 Authorized giving free membership to any plaque purchaser who is not already a member.
- 1/19/1994 Criteria for Historic Landmark Plaque Program approved. (see copy of Criteria in Vital Documents binder.)
