Subject: Honorary Trustees/Regents

1/6/1976 "The Executive Committee recommend to the Association that a Class of Honorary Trustees be initiated. This class would be designed for retiring Trustees that are interested in remaining active, but they would be without voting power."

4/11/1995 Board adopted plan to replace Honorary Trustee designation with "Regent." Regents may attend meetings but will not have a vote. Regents would be encouraged/expected to attend several Board Meetings per year.

5/9/2020 Revised Code of Regulations states:

"The Board of Trustees may create a class of "Regents" for retiring Trustees. A Regent shall not have voting power and shall serve solely in an advisory capacity. Regents are expected to attend at least three Board meetings per year."
